

# Putting the brakes on

NEW safety moves are on the way for **Rossall** promenade after county councillors agreed to tackle boy racers.

The youths have been driving at high speed along the promenade.

But now Lancashire County Council has agreed to change traffic priorities and construct an "outbuild" to slow them down.

Jane Littlewood, chair of Rossall Residents' Association, said: "It was an issue of safety and

anti-social behaviour that will be tackled by this new policy.

Local committee and was one of the first of its kind in the county."

Work will take place later this year.
